ANNUAL AIR EMISSION REPORTING

May 1, 2009 is the deadline for submittal of the **2008 Annual Emission Report**. This is required of all Illinois facilities that have, or should have, an Illinois EPA air permit.

If you have a Title V (CAAPP) air permit, May 1 is also the deadline for the Annual Compliance Certification (401-CAAPP Form). The Annual Compliance Certification has significant importance in that the facility's compliance status is to be documented in detail for the previous year. The Illinois EPA reviews each of the 401-CAAPP form submittals very carefully.

Is your Annual Compliance Certification Complete? For Title V compliance, the Agency expects each facility to list the compliance status for all applicable permit terms and conditions, including construction permits that have been issued but have not been incorporated into the CAAPP permit. Given the Agency's current backlog in permit updates, there are many construction permits that have yet to be incorporated into the CAAPP permits.
