

## **UPCOMING STORM WATER PERMIT COMPLIANCE ISSUES AND DEADLINES**

### **DEADLINE**

**June 30<sup>th</sup>** is Illinois EPA's deadline for most companies holding NPDES Storm Water Permits to file their **Annual Facility Inspection Report**

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT**

The EPA also requires companies that are covered by the permit to provide a current Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan that includes implementation of **Best Management Practices**.

### **THOUSANDS OF ILLINOIS COMPANIES AFFECTED**

Even companies that do not have storm water exposed to industrial activity are required to file a **No Exposure Certification**. The EPA maintains that there are thousands of Illinois companies that are required to file this form.

### **SMALL CONSTRUCTION ALSO**

Small Construction activities that disturb more than one acre of land are now required to have an NPDES **Storm Water Permit** and implement **Best Management Practices**.

### **COMBINED SEWER EXCEPTION**

Storm water permitting rules do not apply to facilities that are serviced only by a combined sewer system, as is much of the City of Chicago.
