REMINDER NOTICE OF CHEMICAL REPORTING

WHAT IS TIER TWO REPORTING?

Tier Two Hazardous Chemical Inventory Reports.

Owners or operators of facilities that have hazardous chemicals on hand in quantities equal to or greater than set threshold levels must submit Tier Two report forms. The forms are submitted to the local fire department, and to the County and State Emergency Planning Agencies. **In Illinois, the state submittal must be done online, including attachments.**

Common chemicals such as acid in forklift batteries, ammonia, and fuel oil are frequently overlooked by facilities, but are subject to reporting. Companies have been fined by the U.S. EPA for failing to file this report.

DEADLINE

March 1 is the deadline for submittal of the Tier Two.

SPECIAL CHICAGO RULES

The City of Chicago adopted regulations in February 2009 for Tier 2 reporting. They require a detailed **emergency preparedness diagram**, which is more extensive than the federal rules. Chicago also has enforcement authority.
