SPECIAL NOTICE
VISIBLE EMISSION TESTING FOR TITLE V PERMITS

Many Title V permits that have been issued or renewed recently require **visible emission observations to be conducted at least annually** for particulate matter emission units. This is often a new monitoring requirement that you may be surprised by.

The visible emission test is to be conducted in accordance with US EPA Method 22. This method indicates only the presence or absence of particulate matter emissions over a certain observation period. The observation period must be at least six minutes in duration for each emission unit.

Admiral can conduct the visible emission observations in accordance with your permit requirements. All observations will be documented on field record forms.
